

**STATUS REPORT ON GOVERNMENT OF INDIA SCHEMES UNDER IMPLEMENTATION IN GOA  
SARVA SHIKSHA ABHIYAN**

Goa Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan deals with the following interventions. Details of each intervention with the present status are furnished here below. Tabular representation of the status is furnished at the end of the write up.

**INTERVENTIONS FOR OUT OF SCHOOL CHILDREN**

Provision of Special Training for drop-out children or never-enrolled children is made under this intervention. Special Training is provided for identified children at Special Training Centers (STCs). These centers are either school-based or NGO-based. Duration of period of special training varies from 10 months to 2 years depending on age of the child. Funding is provided @ Rs. 500/- per child per month

**VARIOUS INTERVENTIONS FOR CWSN**

SSA has to ensure that every child with special needs (CWSN), irrespective of kind, category and degree of disability is provided education in an appropriate environment. Identification of the children with special needs is an integral part of the micro planning and household survey. Every disabled child and every child with special need is entitled for Rs. 3000 after getting identified during survey. No cash amount is given to the children with special needs.

The amount of Rs. 3000/- is spent on activities pertaining to IED i.e. early detection of children with special needs, identification of children with special needs, aids and appliances and support services like physical access, special equipment, reading material and resource support of resource teachers, special educational techniques remedial teaching, etc.

**FREE TEXT BOOKS**

Sarva Shiksha Abhiyan will support provision of textbooks to all children (I to VIII).The upper ceiling limit of Rs. 150/- per child for textbooks is for Primary

students and Rs. 250/- per child for textbooks is for Upper Primary students. The charges on textbooks development, printing, transportation etc. will also be included with the cost of textbooks, provided the upper ceiling limit of Rs. 150/- per child (Primary) and Rs. 250/- per child (Upper Primary) shall not exceed.

#### **UNIFORMS:**

Two sets of uniform from classes I to VIII for all girls, and children belonging to SC/ST/BPL families in Government Schools within a ceiling of Rs. 400/- per child per annum.

#### **SCHOOL GRANTS**

This grant is released to Government schools and Government Aided Schools @ Rs. 5000/- and for Primary Schools and @ Rs. 7000/- to Upper Primary Schools once in an academic year. The purpose of this grant is towards replacement of non-functional school equipment, library books for schools can also be provided from this grant.

#### **MAINTENANCE GRANT**

This grant is applicable only to Government Schools and it is an annual grant. Schools with up to three classrooms are eligible for maintenance grant @ Rs. 5000/- per school per year, while schools having more than three classrooms would get a maintenance grant of Rs. 10000/- per school per year etc.. The purpose of the grant is to provide annual maintenance and repair of existing school building and other facilities to up keep the infrastructure in good condition. Necessary guidelines are issued to the schools while releasing the grant. Grant will be available only for those schools which have existing building of their own;

grant will be available also to those Government Schools in Urban areas which are running in rented building.

- \* Note Headmaster room and office room would not count as classroom for this purpose.

## **TEACHERS GRANT**

A grant @ Rs. 500/- per teacher per year for primary and upper primary is given to teachers of Government Schools and Government Aided schools. It is an annual grant which is released to the teachers through PTA's. The purpose of the grant is towards procurement of teaching learning material for classroom teaching and the time submission of the Utilization Certificate is within one month of the close of the financial

## **TEACHERS TRAINING**

Teachers' training is provided by GSSA to teachers of Government Schools and Government Aided Schools. It is to be ensured that the unit cost of Rs. 200 per day per teacher for Block Level Training and Rs. 100 per day per teachers for Cluster Level Training and the no. of days for each type of training is to be strictly adhered, Cost of development of training modules and teachers guide should be within the overall training of Rs. 200/- and Rs. 100.

All teachers from government and government primary and primary schools were imparted training in subject wise Learning Outcomes preparing them for c-NAS that was scheduled to be conducted on November 13, 2017. The training programmes were held for three and two days respectively in July and September 2017 at the level of the Block Resource Centers.

Similarly training to about 200 resource persons for building their capacities for conduct of the NAS 2017 was organized wherein as per NCERT guidelines teacher trainees from the teacher education institutions were covered. The training was imparted by the Master Trainers trained for the purpose. These Master Trainers were the state level experts functioning in Goa SSA and SCERT.

## **RESEARCH EVALUATION AND MONITORING SURVEY (REMS) SHAALA SIDDHI**

The Directorate of Education is approved as the 'State Nodal Agency' for the Programme. The State Project Director, GSSA is the 'State Nodal Officer' to monitor implementation of the programme. All BRCCs, BRPs and CRPs are trained in Shaala Siddhi . Time line and action plan is formulated for its implementation.

During the year 2016-17, Shaala Siddhi programme is implemented in all Upper Primary, Secondary and Higher Secondary schools totally 526 schools. All Primary schools would be covered during the year 2017-18 however, PAB approval was not accorded to the proposal.

## **LEARNING ENHANCEMENT PROGRAMME**

Teacher prepared **worksheets** in the subjects of EVS, English, & Mathematics for classes I to IV. Printed booklets containing sample worksheets will be brought out for the use of teachers and students.

## **SMC TRAINING TARGET & ACHIEVEMENT**

School Management Committees have been trained in various aspects of RTE 2009 and in helping schools to perform better with Community support. Encouraging Proactive involvement of SMCs and Community involvement in school improvement was the focus of the Training Programme. Provisions of RTE Act 2009, Role of Community & SMC in school development, Shala Siddhi,

Vidyanjali, SDP, Social Audit were the main points discussed in the Training Programme.

## CIVIL WORKS

The construction of civil works would be allowed for Government owned school buildings only. In no case would it be allowed to Government aided schools. Participation of the community in all civil work activities will be mandatory, engagements of contractors will not be allowed except for the construction of multistoried urban schools with the permission of PAB.

The Civil Work construction covers:-

Toilets, Drinking Water Facility, Compound Wall, Electrical Rewiring, Major Repairs, Ramps, Verandah Grills etc.
